Professional sports and events throughout the year: Berlin is a happening city for sports fans!

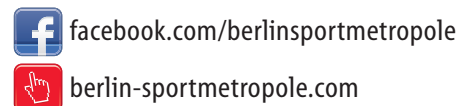
Berlin is Germany's top city for sport and sports fans. High-class events attract sports enthusiasts and spectators from around the world.

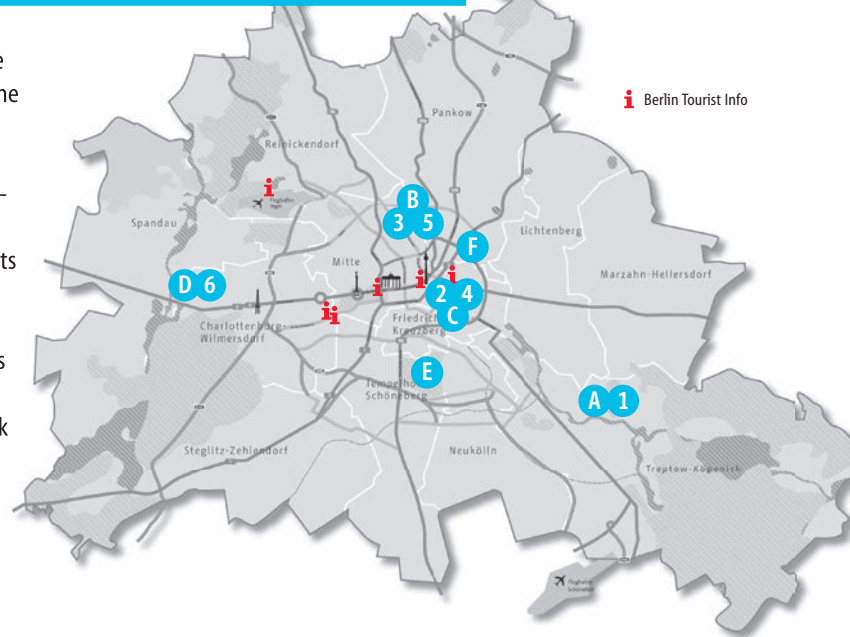
six elite pro sports clubs in five sporting disciplines, Berlin is the capital of sport!

### Alte Försterei

### Max-Schmeling-Halle

### Mercedes-Benz Arena

### Olympic Stadium
